Programme Fees for September 2020 Intake

Fees for the course are £12,000

Once we have accepted your application, checked references, and confirmed a place for you on the course, you will be required to pay a non-refundable £500 deposit in order to secure your place.

Fee Options

Option 1 – Payment Plan

After the initial £500 deposit has been made, a second payment of £2,500 will be due by 30 July 2020 (6 weeks before the commencement of the training), followed by twelve equal monthly instalments of £750 between September 2020 and August 2021.

Total £12,000

Option 2 – Payment in full before the commencement of the training

After the initial £500 deposit has been paid, a 5% discount is offered on the total fee if payment of fees is made in full by 30 July 2020.

Total £11,400

Cancellation and Refund Policy

Once you have accepted an offer of a place, it is with the understanding that:

1. Once the training has commenced:
 - a. The place that has been offered to you is not transferrable to any other person or any other training institution for the duration of the intake.
 - b. If you decide to withdraw from the training, there will be no refund of any payments made on account.
 - c. Full payment of any unpaid fees will remain owing until settled.
2. In all circumstances, all payments made on account are non-refundable, excepting clause 5 (below).
3. If a student is unable to continue in the programme due to unforeseen and unavoidable circumstance, a discretionary credit may be considered.
4. If a credit is issued, it can only be applied against the fees for the next available WIT UK entry-level training programme.
5. In the unlikely case of WIT UK cancelling the intake before training has commenced, all fees paid to WIT UK will be returnable, or credit to the amount paid will be offered towards a future intake. Monies returned will be limited to fees only and will not include any accommodation, transport or other costs incurred to any student.
6. Non-attendance does not warrant a refund or credit.
